SPOT CLEANING TIPS

Protein stains	Tannin Stains	Oil Based Stains	Dye Stains
Baby food, milk, mucus, blood, cheese sauce, mud, cream or pudding, egg, urine, feces, vomit, white glue, ice cream. 1. Remove excess matter first. 2. Apply a detergent or spot remover that contains enzymes (For detergents, use only with cold water. Warm or hot water will set the protein stain). 3. Blot with a white clot 4. Launder with the enzyme detergent if the stain is stubborn.	Alcohol beverages, berries Coffee, cologne, felt tip water colored pen or washable ink, fruit juice, soft drinks, tea, tomato juice. 1. Apply a detergent or spot remover that contains enzymes. 2. Do not use soap (bar or flake). Soaps set the stain. 3. Launder the product Immediately if possible.	Hair oils, bacon fat, hand and face lotions, butter/margarine, mayonnaise, salad dressing, cooking fats and oils. 1. Apply a detergent or stain spray to the stain and work it in. 2. Blot stain with a white cloth. 3. Suntan products are best removed by pre-treating the stains with a heavy liquid detergent, aerosol petroleum spray, or a pump-type detergent-based pretreatment spray. 4. If the stain persist, wash the product as recommended and repeat.	Cherry and blueberry, felt pens, grass, Kool Aid, mustard and tempera paint. 1. Pre-treat the stain with Ecolab® Stain Blaster. 2. For stubborn stains, soak in a dilution of all-fabric powdered bleach (The drawback to using bleach is that it removes color and weakens threads in the fabric). 2. Launder as needed.
