Safety

WARNING: Read all safety warnings and instructions prior to use.

CAPACITY: Do not place more than 1,000 lb. on this cart.

ASSEMBLY: Make sure all bolts are properly tightened. This includes the bolts located on the bottom of the elbows.

SAVE ALL WARNINGS AND INSTRUCTIONS FOR FUTURE REFERENCE.

CORRECT SAFETY PRACTICES

- **Inspect the Cart:** Before each use, check the cart for any signs of wear, damage, or missing components.
- Know the Capacity: Understand the maximum weight and size capacity of the panel cart and never exceed it.
- Load Evenly: Ensure panels are evenly distributed and balanced to prevent tipping.
- Secure the Load: If the cart is equipped with straps or clamps, use them to securely fasten the material.
- **Use Two People:** For very large or heavy panels, always have two people to help load, unload, and move the cart.
- **Push, Don't Pull**: It's generally safer to push the cart rather than pull it. This gives you better control and visibility.
- Move Slowly: Especially when fully loaded, move at a slow, controlled pace to avoid accidents.
- **Use on Even Surfaces:** Whenever possible, use the panel cart on flat and even surfaces to avoid tipping or losing control.
- **Store Properly:** When not in use, store the cart in a safe place where it won't create a tripping hazard.
- **Oil:** Oil the swivel wheels regularly to maintain mobility.

INCORRECT SAFETY PRACTICES

- Overload: Never load the cart beyond its specified weight or size capacity.
- **Use on Steep Slopes:** Avoid using the cart on steep inclines or declines where it can easily tip or get away from you.
- Leave Unattended: Especially when loaded, never leave the cart unattended.
- Ignore Damages: If the cart is damaged, do not use it until it has been repaired.
- Stack Precariously: Don't stack panels so high that they become unstable or block your view.
- **Rush:** Never rush while moving the cart, as this can lead to accidents.
- **Modify the Cart:** Avoid making any modifications to the cart that might compromise its structural integrity or safety features.
- **Drag or Force Movements:** If the cart becomes stuck or difficult to move, don't forcefully jerk or drag it. Instead, reassess the situation and adjust as needed.
- **Ignore Surroundings:** Always be aware of your surroundings and especially of other people to prevent accidents or collisions.







Assembly Instructions

- 1. Insert one elbow (1) into a set of openings on the base (2) as shown below.
- 2. Repeat Step 1 for the other two elbows.



Caster Replacement Instructions

Casters are preassembled to the base of the panel cart. If a caster needs to be replaced, please follow the instructions below to attach the new caster.

Turn over the base (2) and assemble the caster (3 or 8) using a flat washer (5), a spring washer (6), a nut (7), and a screw (4).
