# **Automatic Soap / Sanitizer Dispenser**

### Warning:

Take care not to spill any liquids into the dispenser when filling as this can interfere with the components inside that allow the unit to function properly.

### **Mounting Instructions:**

- 1. Find a suitable installation location that complies with applicable guidelines.
- 2. Locate the hardware kit that comes with the unit. It will include four screws, washers, and drywall anchors, as well as one blue key.
- 3. Use the blue key to open the unit by putting it into the keyhole located at the top of the unit and twisting until the front cover opens.
- 4. Remove the liquid container inside to give you access to the back plate. It is recommended that you grab the container by the sides to pull it out.
- 5. With the unit open, hold the unit against the desired mounting location and use a marking tool to mark each screw hole on the wall through the dispenser. When done, set aside the dispenser.
- 6. Drill holes into the marked locations and insert the drywall anchors into each hole.
- 7. While holding the dispenser against the wall, thread a screw through a washer and screw it into one of the drilled holes. Repeat this step for each screw.
- 8. Once the unit is fully mounted, replace the previously removed liquid container. Make sure the container is fully into place.

# **Automatic Soap / Sanitizer Dispenser**

## **Loading Batteries:**

#### STEP 1


Before filling, it is recommended that batteries are loaded into the unit. Four AA batteries (not included) are required for operation of this unit.

#### STEP 3

Insert batteries by sliding them into place into the battery chambers. Ensure the batteries are inserted with the correct polarity; the symbols on the interior of the chambers will indicate how to do this.

### STEP 2

Open the unit's front cover and use the diagram to locate where the battery housing cover is. Remove the battery housing cover.



STEP 4

Replace the battery cover.

#### **Operational Features:**

The unit features an LED battery status indicator light that details the battery life left.

**Green** = Charge level full.

**Yellow =** Charge level medium.

**Red =** Charge level low.

Flashing red = Batteries will need to be replaced very soon.

### **Cleaning:**

A damp cloth is recommended to remove dust or other dirt when needed.
