

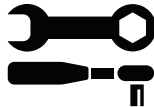

FINISHED ASSEMBLY, ALL WMX:

- Stile Assembly • Back Panel • Base Panel
- 1/2"-13x3 Hex Head Cap Screw, Zinc Plated, Grade 5, x6, A-301-1255
- 1/2"-13 Nylon Insert Hex Locknut, Zinc Plated, x6, A-301-4404

ADDITIONALLY FOR 11-15 STEP WMX:

- Braces, x2
- 1/2"-13x1-1/4" Hex Head Cap Screw, Zinc Plated, Grade 5, x4, A-301-1500
- 1/2"-13 Nylon Insert Hex Locknut Zinc Plated, x4, A-301-4404

ASSEMBLY

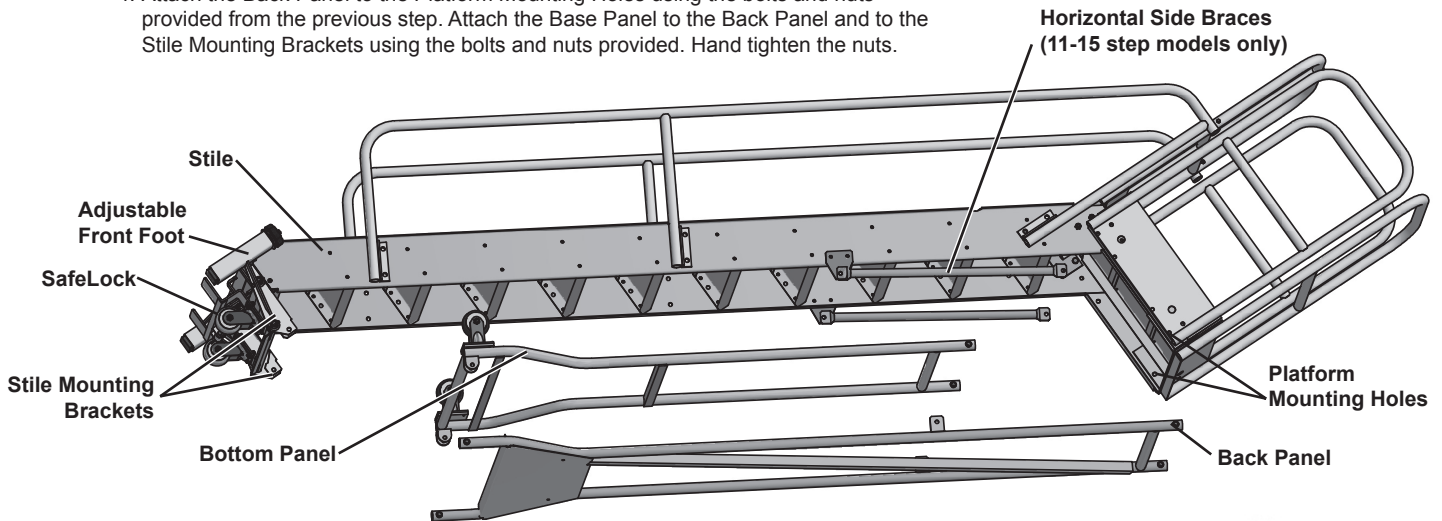
- Read and Understand these instructions fully before installing, assembling or using these ladders.

- Always use a separate ladder or scaffold to finish assembly in high places.
- Never climb a ladder that is not completely assembled.
- Do not assemble, install or use a ladder with missing or damaged parts.
- Use proper lifting mechanics when assembling a ladder.
- Watch for, and avoid overhead electrical hazards and obstructions.

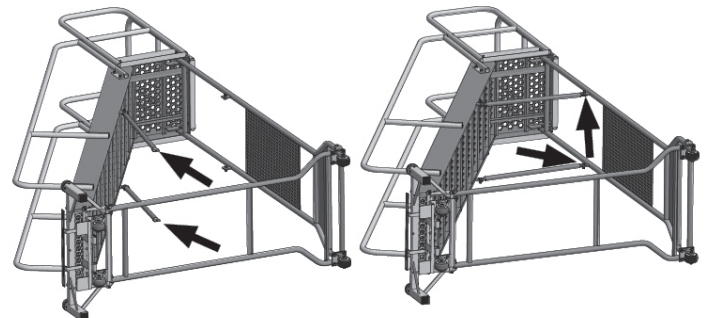


ASSEMBLY SETUP

1. Ladders up to 6-step may ship fully-assembled.
2. Lay the ladder on its side. Have as many people help as necessary to maneuver the ladder safely.
3. Cut the banding to free the Back Panel, Base and Stile assembly. Remove the bolts and nuts from the Stile Mounting Brackets. Cut the zip-ties to free the Base Panel from the Back Panel. Remove the bolts and nuts from the Platform Mounting Holes: DO NOT DISCARD.
4. Attach the Back Panel to the Platform Mounting Holes using the bolts and nuts provided from the previous step. Attach the Base Panel to the Back Panel and to the Stile Mounting Brackets using the bolts and nuts provided. Hand tighten the nuts.

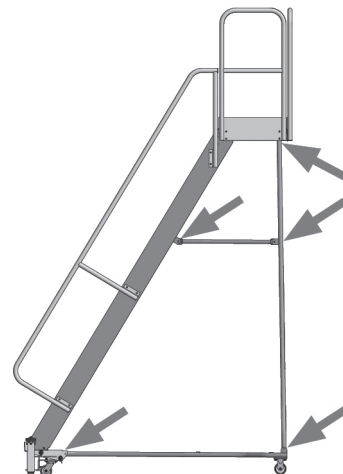


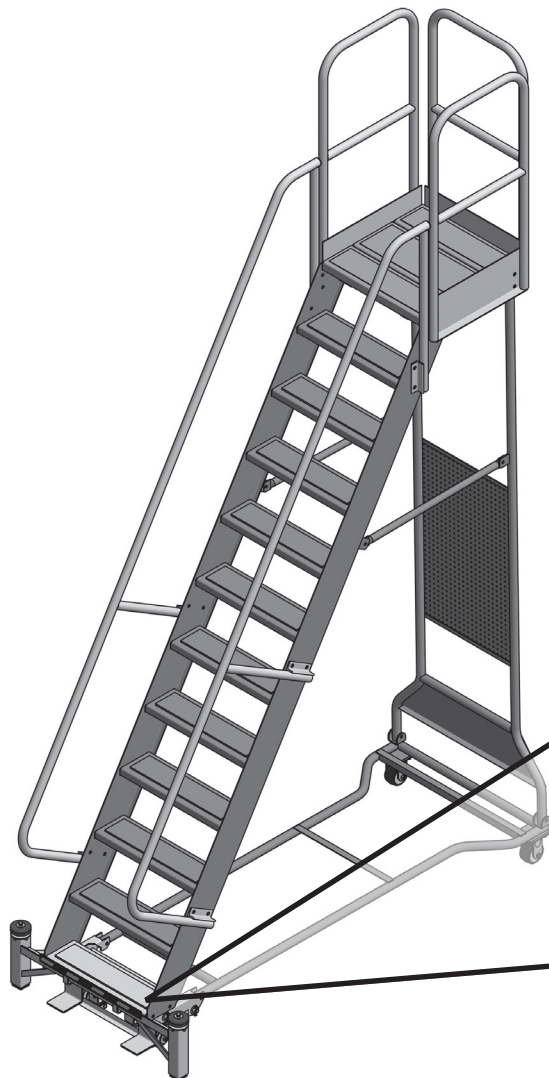
5. Horizontal Side Braces, 11-15 step models only: Braces are bolted into lug and free end zip tied to stile. Remove zip tie and swing the Horizontal Side Braces to the Back Panel and secure using the bolts and nuts provided in place.



6. Stand the ladder upright. Have as many people help as necessary to maneuver the ladder safely. Use proper lifting mechanics when assembling a ladder.

7. Tighten the bolts and nuts (on both sides) that connect the Stile, Back Panel, Base Panel and Horizontal Side Braces.





8. Remove the zip tie securing the SafeLock™ mechanism.
9. With the ladder raised on its front wheels, use the knobs to adjust the Front Foot height as needed. The ladder should stand plumb and level when lowered onto the Front Feet.

MAINTENANCE



DANGER! Death or serious injury may occur if improperly assembled or used. Always consult and follow directions of a Qualified Person.

1. Make sure all hex-nuts and hex-head bolts are tightly fastened. All bolted connections MUST be secure.
2. Inspect upon receipt and before each use. Never climb if any components are damaged, bent or broken. All parts MUST be in good working order.
3. Check to make sure labels are visible and readable. Contact Cotterman® to replace any worn or missing label.
4. Front feet MUST be in firm contact with the floor when ladder is occupied.
5. Keep clean, free from grease, oil and all slippery and foreign materials. Keep your shoes clean.
