## **Backrest installation**

- 1. Carefully remove tube closures that are located on top of each side frame of the stool. This should be done by gently inserting a thin screwdriver underneath the tube closure and carefully prying upwards. See ill. A.
- 2. Remove backrest from carton and place rubber O-rings over inner backrest tubes. See ill. B.
- 3. Begin installation by aligning metal tubes that protrude from the backrest with the opening of the stool frames. See ill. C.
- 4. Simultaneously insert both ends of the backrest tubes into the stool opening. Gently push until backrest tubes are flush with stool.
- 5. Insert the screws into the holes that are located just below the seat on each side of the stool (See ill. D) and tighten them using the provided Alan key.

## Backrest removal

- 1. Remove screws from frame with provided Alan key.
- 2. The backrests are built to fit very tightly into the stool frame and some resistance may be encountered while attempting to remove. For easiest removal <u>do not pull</u> from plastic part of backrest but rather place hands at the bottom of the tubes on each side and pull while wiggling the tubes upwards.
