Cooked: Dark brown on the inside with a translucent coat on the outside



Round shape. Very thin, transparent outer shell with juice sealed inside. Color varies based on the juice flavor.



Rough round shape. Translucent. Color may vary based on the flavor.



Light caramel flavor, chewy.



Bouncy and soft outer shell and the juice liquid together create a fun burst when you bite.



Subtle citrusy flavor. Gelatin-like, crunchy texture.
