FIRST USE —	<ul> <li>Before first use, wash dinnerware in hot water using mild detergent (rinse and dry before storing)</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Handwashing is recommended for all handmade products</li> </ul>
HANDLING —	<ul> <li>After clearing tables, immediately remove food remnants from ceramics with a soft dish cloth or sponge</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Avoid using abrasive materials (steel wool, metal scrapers, scouring pads), to remove debris</li> </ul>
PRE-SOAKING —	<ul> <li>Soak in 140-160°F water with chlorine-free, acid-free, non-abrasive detergent for 10-20 minutes</li> </ul>
WASHING —	<ul> <li>Wash as soon as possible, using a peg rack to maximize water contact with dishware</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Utilize appropriately-sized glass racks for cups to avoid damage</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Ceramics are safe for both high and low temperature commercial dish machines unless otherwise noted</li> </ul>
	<ul> <li>Handwashing is recommended for handmade products to extend their service life</li> </ul>
DRYING — (AFTERWASH)	Remove residual water by drying with a soft cloth or towel

- Consult your chemical supplier to ensure use of recommended products for best results with your dishwasher and water conditions
