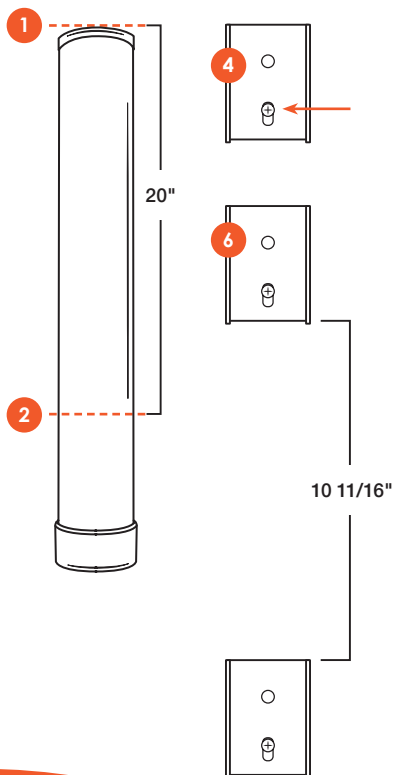
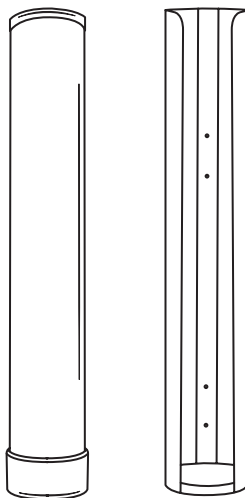




Wall-Mount Cup Dispenser & Lid Organizer Installation Instructions

651CPDWLSS1, 651CPDWLSS2, 651CPDWLSS3,
651CPOWLSS1, 651CPOWLSS2, 651CPOWLSS3



1 Determine where you want to install the dispenser/organizer and hold it up against the wall. Make a mark on the wall with a pencil at the top of the unit and put it aside.

2 Make another mark 20" below the first mark. This is where the top of the bottom bracket will start.

3 Align the top of a bracket at the mark made in Step 2. The oval-shaped hole should be on the bottom of the bracket, and the extended sides of the bracket should be facing you.

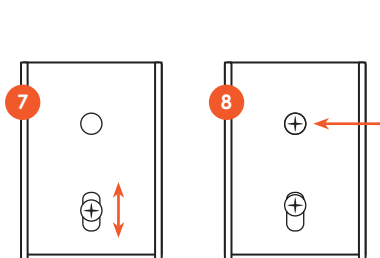
4 Holding the bracket in place, fasten a screw in the bottom hole.

Optional: If required for your setup, use drywall anchors.

5 Measure 10 11/16" upwards from the top of the bracket you just installed. Mark this measurement with a horizontal line in pencil. This will be the bottom of the top bracket. Ensure measurement is vertically aligned with the bottom bracket.

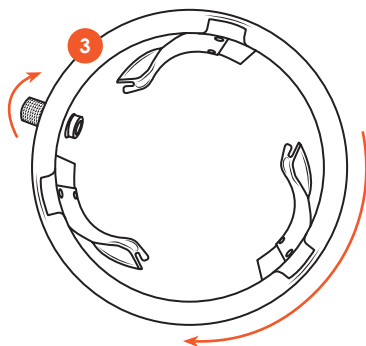
6 Install top bracket by aligning the lower edge with the line created in Step 5. Ensure the top bracket is vertically level with the bottom bracket. Then, install a screw into the lower oval-shaped hole.

Optional: If required for your setup, use drywall anchors.



- 7** Test mount the unit on the brackets. If the unit doesn't fully sit in both wall-mount brackets, adjust one or both of the brackets by loosening the screws in the oval holes and sliding up or down.
- 8** After the fit is secure on both brackets, remove unit and install 2 more screws in the top screw holes of the top and bottom brackets.
- 9** Mount your organizer or dispenser into the wall brackets, making sure the tracks fully align and are secure inside the brackets.

Adjusting & Filling Cup Dispensers



- 1** If the unit is mounted on a wall, remove and place horizontally on a countertop. Remove top lid of dispenser and set aside.
- 2** Slide a stack of cups through the top opening of the dispenser with the tops of the cups facing upwards.
Using your other hand at the bottom of the dispenser, guide the stack of cups down the tube. Make sure the stack fits between the dispenser arms inside the unit.
- 3** Adjust the collar by loosening the adjustment knob and rotating the collar. As the collar gets tighter, the dispensing arms inside will create a smaller diameter.
Tighten the adjustment knob and then test the dispenser on the wall brackets. Readjust until the cups stay inside the unit without falling out and you can dispense one cup at a time.
Remount on wall bracket and reinstall lid to the top of the dispenser.
