Assembly Instructions — Classic Activity Leg

Leg Designed for use with Econoline Activity Tables.

Tools Required:

 #2 Phillips head screw driver or cordless screwdriver with #2 Phillips bit

Step 1

Place the table topside down on a clean, non scratching surface.


Step 2

Leg locations are marked for proper installation.

Place leg at the proper location using markings as a guide.

Install Phillips head screws (provided) through the slotted center hole and into the table top. Tighten fully and repeat for remaining seven holes.


Repeat step 2 for the remaining legs.



Step 3

Adjust each leg to desired height using the provided Hex wrench.

Using two people, turn the table upright and rotate Nylon Glides as necessary to level table.

Melamine Econoline Top <u>USE & CARE INTRUCTIONS</u>

A Melamine work surface will give you years of service if used with the same care you would give to a real wood furniture top.

- 1. Clean surface with a damp cloth, and then dry. Use a couple of drops of dishwashing detergent for stubborn stains. Be sure to dry the top after cleaning.
- 2. Crayons marks may be removed by using a cloth dampened with a few drops of mineral spirits (paint thinner, Goo Gone, Good Off), or similar solvent. Then wipe the surface dry.
- 3. Permanent marker can be removed by using a cloth dampened with a few drops of fingernail polish remover, or lacquer thinner. Then wipe the surface dry.
- 4. Do not leave wet objects on the top for long periods of time. Wipe up spills at once.
- 5. Do not place hot objects directly on the table top.
- 6. Use care to prevent scratching the top. Melamine is scratch <u>resistant</u>, it is not scratch <u>proof</u>. Treat the top with the same care you would give to the wood furniture in your home or office, and it will give you years of service.
