

FLOOR GRIP CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

Floors treated with SlipDoctors® Floor Grip will provide effective slip resistance for years with proper maintenance. We recommend the following cleaning process. Floors with heavy levels of contaminants may require more frequent cleaning.

RECOMMENDED EQUIPMENT

- pH-Neutral Floor Cleaner
- Microfiber Mop
- Clean Water

CLEANING PROCESS

- 1. Read all product labels thoroughly to determine suitability for the intended use.
- 2. Remove debris from the floor by sweeping, vacuuming or dusting the surface.
- 3. Using a pH-neutral floor cleaner and a microfiber mop, thoroughly clean the floor to remove dirt and other contaminants. Rinse with clean water and allow to dry.
- 4. Depending on the level of contaminants on the floor, you may need to clean the floor more than once.
