

WASHING INSTRUCTIONS: 100% Cotton Table Linen

MACHINE WASH



Wash at 60°C (140F)

BLEACH



Do not bleach

IRON



Iron at medium to high setting (not exceeding 180°C / 356F)

DRY



Tumble dry at medium heat (not exceeding 65°C / 150F)

GENERAL TIPS

Don't mix cotton rich and 100% cotton linens - it will cause fabric damage

Always shake out linens before laundering

Keep linens clear of the floor - floor stains are difficult to remove

One of the most common laundering problems is machine overloading. It should be 70-75% filled

WASHING – Follow product label care

Intense / Dark Colors (such as red, black, navy, etc) do not use bleach(including Hydrogen Peroxide) and wash separately the first few times.

White / Light colors wash with high quality detergent containing sodium percarbonate (an oxygen bleach product).

Use high quality detergent (OBA Brightener-free for colors) to swell cotton fibers, releasing the dirt.

Hot water is essential to removing oil and grease stains

Do not use bleach

DRYING & IRONING

Iron while damp

For ironer – 20 meters per min (66 feet/min)

Always feed fabric into iron along the warp (vertically woven yarns) to prevent stretching

If any logo is embroidered the product needs to be ironed with the logo on the side up to protect it and prevent scorching

Always check to see if a treated stain was removed after laundering and before ironing. The heat will set the stain

Linen must be still damp before ironing

Press at 15-18 bars with intermittency or use centrifugal machine



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LAUNDERING STEPS

	Water level	Temperature	Time/Duration	Instructions
Wash	<i>Medium</i>	<i>100F</i>	<i>5 min</i>	<i>Do not drain</i>
Increase Temperature	<i>Medium</i>	<i>60°C (140F) for whites 60°C (140F) for colors</i>	<i>10 min</i>	<i>Do not drain</i>
Cool down	<i>High</i>	<i>40°C (100F)</i>	<i>5 min</i>	<i>Run cold water in machine. Drain</i>
Cold rinse	<i>High</i>	<i>Cold</i>	<i>3 min</i>	<i>Drain</i>
Starch (optional)	<i>Low</i>	<i>Cold</i>	<i>5 min</i>	<i>Add starch before soaking. Drain</i>
Warm rinse (if starch added)	<i>Low</i>	<i>40°C (100F)</i>	<i>3 min</i>	<i>Helps starch dilution and absorption</i>
Spin/extract water	<i>-</i>	<i>-</i>	<i>8-10 min</i>	<i>Continuous high pressure</i>
