Use & Care Guide

METAL OUTDOOR TABLES & CHAIRS





ASSEMBLY/ARRIVAL

- It is the responsibility of the recipient to inspect the shipment for damage prior to signing the bill of lading. Damages must be reported to your authorized retailer within 5 days of receipt.
- Inspect all welds and fasteners on chairs/barstools/tables for damage before use. Ensure all legs are straight and touching the floor.
- Assembly, if applicable, should be conducted by a qualified adult using the applicable instructions.



STORAGE

- 1. After assembly, do not store upside down.
- It is recommended to use placemats and coasters on tables to prevent scratches, scrapes and warping.





CLEANING INSTRUCTIONS

- Clean using a solution of mild soap or detergent with warm water. Recommended: Noble Lemon Lance (147LMNLANROT).
- For dried-on dirt, clean with a soft brush and a mild cleaner. Recommended: Noble Spiffy Shine (999SPIFSHINE).
- Make sure metal is fully dry after cleaning and before use to prevent rusting and other discoloration.
- Use a clean, dry cloth or a soft duster to dust weekly.



ONGOING MAINTENANCE

 Use caution when stacking, follow specific guidelines per item type for stacking quantities.

MONTHLY

 Ensure the structure is sound and there are no cracks or breaks in the material. Tighten all bolts and screws. Do not overtighten since this may damage the material.



CAUTION

- Do not use a chair/barstool/table if any parts are broken or missing. This includes screws, fasteners, and feet/glides.
- 2. Do not remove any safety labels.
- Always follow cleaning and maintenance instructions.

CHAIRS/BARSTOOLS

- Children should always be supervised by an adult whenever they are using this furniture.
- 2. Do not shake or sway while in use. Keep all four legs on the ground when in use.
- 3. Do not stand on chair/barstools.

TABLES

1. Do not let anyone sit, stand, shake, lean, jump, or climb on table. Do not use this product as a support when leaning and/or standing.
