For more than 150 years, we've bottled Mountain Valley Spring Water from our same, certifiably sustainable source deep in the heart of the Ouachita Mountains. We've worked diligently to protect our source and the lands surrounding it since 1871. In fact, in 2021 Mountain Valley became one of the first spring-water sources to be certified by the Alliance for Water Stewardship, a comprehensive global benchmark for responsible water stewardship.



NATURE'S PERFECT PACKAGING

Our dedication to sustainability extends to our packaging. Mountain Valley has always bottled our premium spring water in glass. Our glass bottles aren't merely iconic, they're also recyclable and endlessly reusable. Many of Mountain Valley's 2.5 and 5-gallon glass jugs have been reused for generations, eliminating the waste and resources used for single-use packaging.



SUPPORTING THE COMMUNITIES WE SERVE

Mountain Valley is proud to support our community and many important causes in the communities we serve. Through a partnership with Friends of the Ouachita Trail (FoOT), we help with maintenance and improvement of the land surrounding our source.
