## **Allergen Statement**

The Oregon Fruit Company (Oregon Fruit) does not produce any products containing any of the nine major food allergens (milk, eggs, peanuts, tree nuts, fish, sesame, shellfish, soy, and wheat) or common sensitizing agents (sulfites, mustard and mustard products, celery and celery products, azo dyes, carmine). These ingredients are not used or stored in this facility.

Oregon Fruit does allow IQF peaches, orange juice concentrate, apple puree, kiwi puree, and banana puree in our plant. These fruits are processed on equipment completely separated from our canning line, and are not run concurrently with our canned fruit. Cross contamination is not a risk, given the separation of equipment and production timing.

## **Gluten Statement**

Gluten is an insoluble protein found in wheat, spelt, kamut, rye, barley, and cross-bred hybrids, such as triticale, which is a cross between wheat and rye. It is estimated that more than two million people in the United States have Celiac disease, a disorder in which the lining of the small intestine is damaged in response to ingestion of gluten. Millions more have varying levels of gluten sensitivity or wheat intolerances, also known as wheat allergies, etc.

Oregon Fruit does not use any ingredients that contain or were derived from any gluten containing grains. Products that contain gluten are not allowed in the processing areas. All products packed or processed by Oregon Fruit are gluten free.
