SUNBRELLA FABRIC CARE

One of the best ways to keep Sunbrella® fabrics looking good is to brush off dirt and debris before it becomes embedded in the fabric and to address messes and spills soon after they occur. The quicker you clean spills, the easier they can be to remove.

CLEANING SUNBRELLA FABRICS

Cleaning should be done 2-3 times per year. Follow instructions bellow:

- Create a mild soap solution. ¼ cup of mild soap such as Dawn®, per gallon of water. You will also need a soft bristle brush or a washcloth.
- 2 Scrub cover with brush/or wash cloth and mild soap solution.
- 3 Rince thoroughly until soap residue is removed.
- Air dry flat and ensure that the fabric is thoroughly dry before reassembly.
- **5** Repeat if necessary.

Sunbrella® fabrics are stain resistant. Taking preventative measures will ensure that stains do not set.

- Blot liquid spills immediately with a clean, dry cloth.
- Spray a mild cleaning solution of soap and water (¼ cup of mild soap per gallon of water).
- 3 Rinse fabric thoroughly to remove all soap residue.
- 4 Air dry flat.
- For severe situations, adhere to the washing/drying instructions below. For oil based spills, apply an absorbent such as corn starch, then remove with a straight edge.





Wash and dry instructions:

- Remove cover from frame (reference manufacturer instructions).
- 2 To wash the cover, use a commercial washing machine and select the delicate wash cycle with cold water. Reference mild laundry detergent and use the normal recommended amounts.
- 3 Air dry flat and ensure that the fabric is thoroughly dry before reassembly. The fabric may have some wrinkling, for these cases use an iron on the synthetic setting.
 - ** Always test iron setting on a small area that is not visible, DO NOT use a steamer or an iron on the steam setting. DO NOT dry clean Sunbrella fabrics.

Sunbrella® fabrics do not promote mildew growth, however, mildew may grow on other foreign substances; make sure to regularly brush off dirt and debris from cover.

To remove mold or mildew:

- Remove cover from frame (reference manufacturer instructions).
- 2 Prepare a solution of 1 cup of bleach and ¼ cup of mild soap per gallon of water.
- 3 Spray on entire area and allow to soak into fabric for 15 minutes.
- Clean entire surface area with sponge, clean towel, or very soft bristle brush.
- Rinse thoroughly to remove all soap residue and air-dry flat. Ensure that the fabric is thoroughly dry before reassembly.

** If the mold/mildew growth is severe, bleach quantity should be increased.
