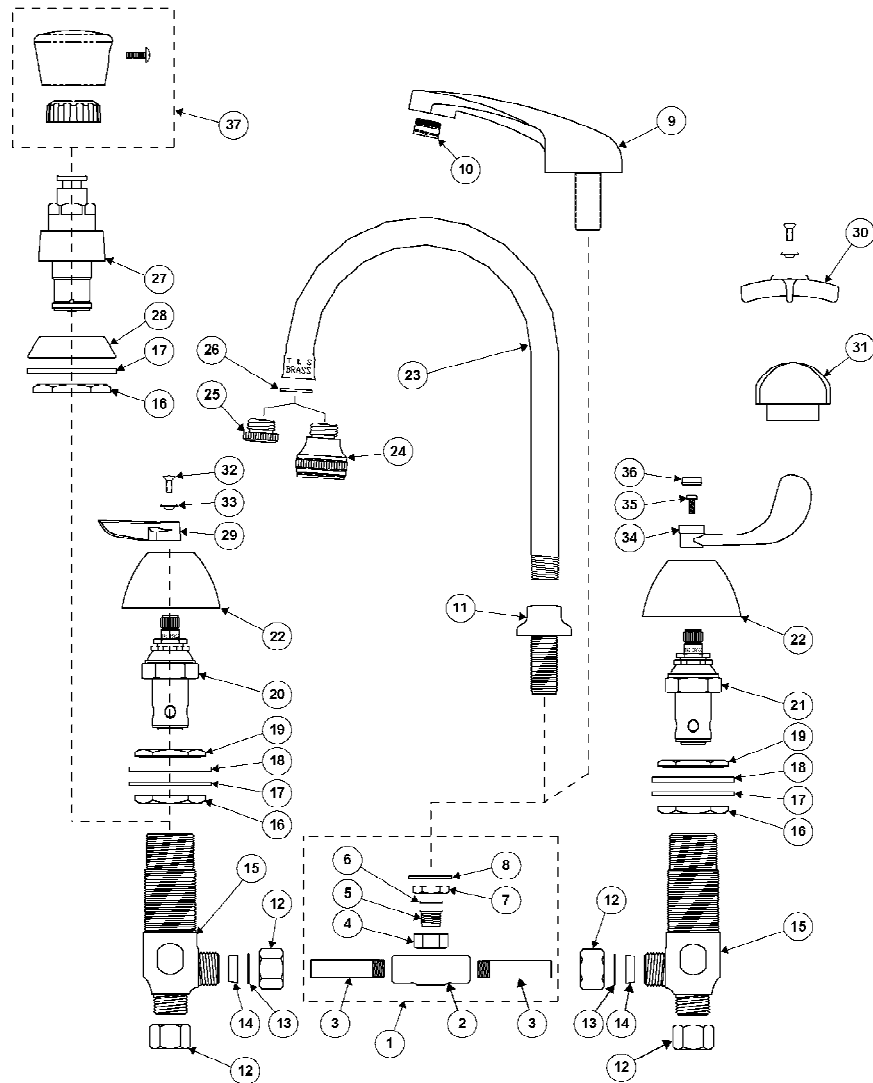

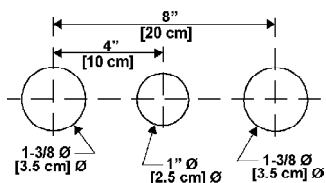

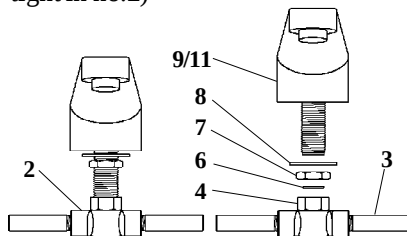
Installation:

Center body and side bodies/faucet

1. Turn off water supply and drain lines. Drill (3) three holes in sink or countertop where you are installing no.1. See illustration below:

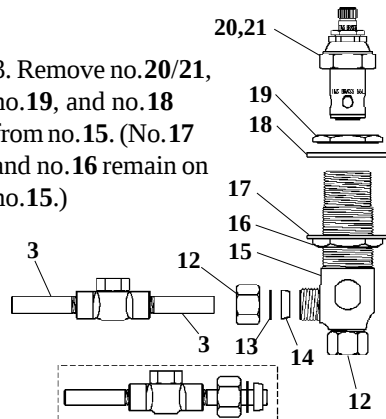


2. Remove no.9/11 from no.2 by holding no.4 with a wrench, then twist no.9/11. Remove no.7 and no.8 from no.9/11. (No.3 should already be tight in no.2)



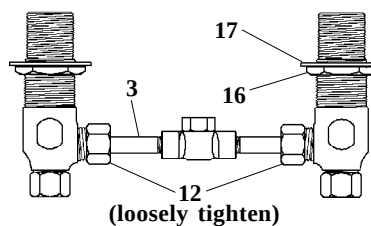
Hot and Cold Side Valves

3. Remove no.20/21, no.19, and no.18 from no.15. (No.17 and no.16 remain on no.15.)

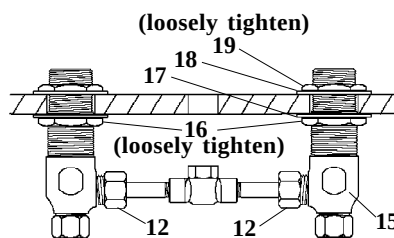


4. Remove no.12, no.13 and no.14 from no.15. Assemble previous items onto arm of no.3, as shown in illustration (below-left). **Both sides.**

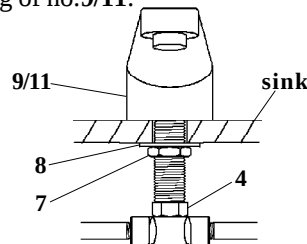
5. Insert no.3 into no.15, loosely tighten no.12 onto threads by hand.



6. Place no.15 assembly into holes from underside of sink. Loosely assemble no.16, and no.17 under sink. Replace no.18 and no.19 onto no.15 at top of sink. Loosely tighten by hand. **Do this for both sides.**

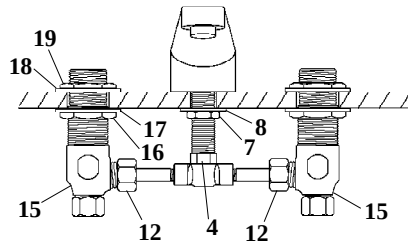


7. Place no.9/11 through hole in sink, and replace no.7 and no.8 onto no.9 from bottom of sink. Adjust no.16 and no.19 to allow proper positioning of no.9/11.

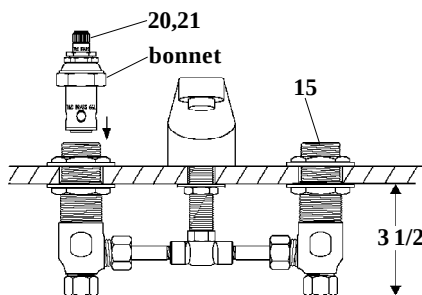
8. Reattach no.9/11 to no.4, making sure no.6 is in place.
9. Tighten no.7 with a wrench against sink bottom.
10. Tighten bottom no.16 on both side no.15 on underside of sink with a wrench. Also, tighten no.12 on no.15 assembly.



Note: When tightening no.7 and no.16, make sure that both no.15's are located at the same height above sink level. Tighten no.7 and no.16 before tightening no.19's

Valve Assembly

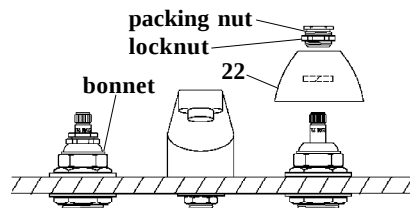
11. Replace no.20 and no.21 on both side no.15 and tighten bonnets sufficiently to seat valve.



12. Remove **packing nut/locknut assembly** from both no.20,21.

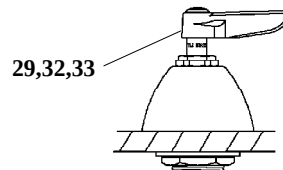
13. Slip no.22 over each no.20,21.

14. **Packing nut and locknut** should be loosely assembled before replacing into no.20,21. Hand-tighten **locknuts only** against no.22. **Do not use a wrench.**



15. Tighten **Packing nut** down against **lock nut** using two wrenches. Hold **lock nut** while rotating **packing nut**.

16. Attach no.29 to no.20,21 and place no.33 in the appropriate no.29. Place no.32 into no.33 and no.29, then tighten.



17. Connect supply lines, turn on water and check for leaks.

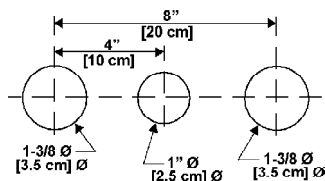
Note: It may become necessary to tighten bonnets and packing nuts to stop leakage from outlet or around spindle assembly.

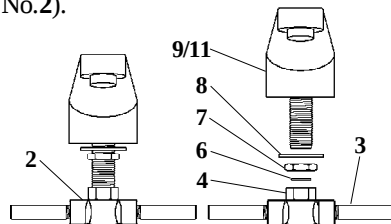
Instalación:

Canillas/Unidad De Centro Y De Lados

1. Cierre la fuente de agua y desagüe las tuberías. Perfore (3) tres huecos en el lavatorio o en el mostrador donde la parte No.1 será instalada. Mire la ilustración abajo.



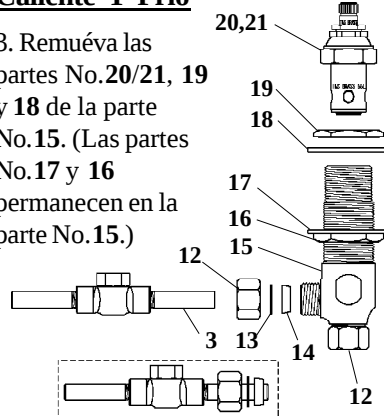
2. Sosteniendo la parte No.4 con una llave, remuévala la parte No.9/11 de la parte No.2, luego destornille la parte No.9/11. Remuévala las partes No.7 y 8 de la parte No.9/11 (La parte No.3 ya debe de estar apretada entre la parte No.2).



Valvulas De Los Lados

Caliente Y Frío

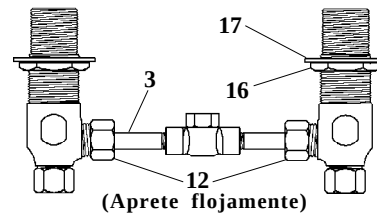
3. Remuévala las partes No.20/21, 19 y 18 de la parte No.15. (Las partes No.17 y 16 permanecen en la parte No.15.)



4. Remuévala las partes No.12, 13 y No.14 de la parte No.15. Ensamble los articulos anteriores en el brazo de la parte No.3 como esta demostrado en la ilustración (abajo -izquierda).

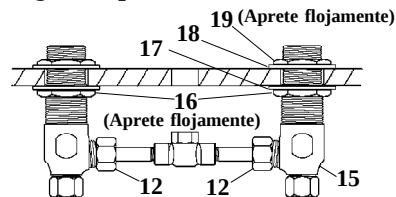
Ambos lados.

5. Inserte la parte No.3 entre la parte No.15, aprete a mano flojamente la parte No.12 en las roscas.

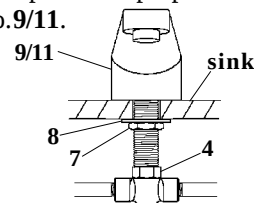


6. Coloque la parte No.15 ensamblada entre los huecos por debajo del lavatorio. Flojamente ensamble las partes No.16 y No.17 debajo del lavatorio. Coloque de nuevo las partes No.18 y No.19 en la parte No.15 sobre el lavatorio. Aprete a mano flojamente.

Haga esto para ambos lados.



7. Coloque la parte No.9/11 a través del hueco en el lavatorio y coloque de nuevo las partes No.7 y No.8 en la parte No.9/11 por debajo del lavatorio. Ajusta las partes No.16 y No.19 para permitir la posición apropiada de la parte No.9/11.

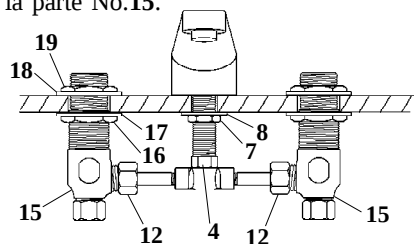

8. Junte de nuevo la parte No.9/11 a la parte No.4, asegurándose que la parte No.6 este situada.

9. Con una llave aprete la parte No.7 contra el fondo del lavatorio.

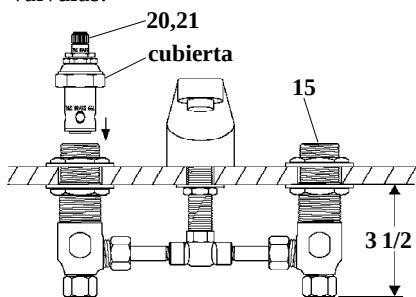
10. Aprete la parte No.16 en ambos lados de la parte No.15 con una llave por debajo del lavatorio. También aprete la parte No.12 al ensamble de la parte No.15.



Nota: Cuando este apretando las partes No.7 y No.16, asegúrese que ambos partes No.15 estén localizadas a la misma altura a nivel sobre el lavatorio. Antes de apretar las partes No.19 aprete las partes No.7 y No.16.

Ensamble De Válvula

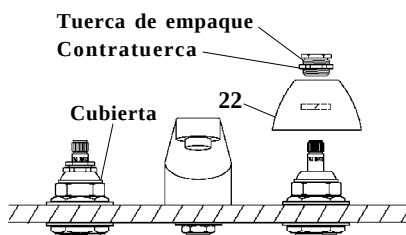
11. Coloque de nuevo la partes No.20 y No.21 en ambos lados en la parte No.15 y aprete las cubiertas suficientemente para acentar las válvulas.



12. Remueva la tuerca de empaque y la contratuerca de ambos lados de las partes No.20 y No.21.

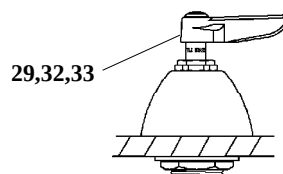
13. Deslice la parte No.22 sobre cada parte No.20 y No.21.

14. La tuerca de empaque y la contratuerca deben ser flojamente ensambladas antes de estar colocadas de nuevo en las partes No.20 y No.21. Aprete a mano solamente la contratuerca contra la parte No.22. **No use llave.**



15. Aprete la tuerca de empaque contra la contratuerca usando llaves. Sostenga la contratuerca mientras que gira la tuerca de empaque.

16. Junte la parte No.29 a las partes No.20 y No.21 y coloque la parte No.33 en la apropiada No.29. Coloque la parte No.32 entre la parte No.33 y No.29 luego aprete.



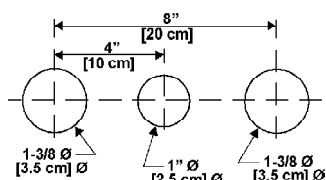
17. Conecte las líneas de surtido, abra la fuente de agua e inspeccione por filtraciones.

Nota: Puede llegar a ser necesario apretar las cubiertas y las tuercas de empaque para parar filtración de la boquilla o alrededor del ensamble del eje.

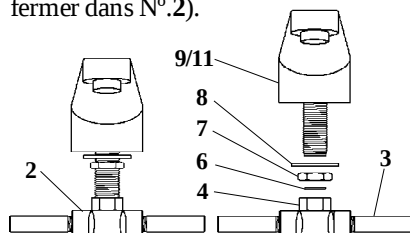

L'Installation: Le centre et le côté: Le robinet

1. Fermer la réserve de l'eau et égoutter la tuyauterie. Percer (3) trous dans l'évier ou le comptoir où vous aller installer N°.1. Voir le diagramme ci-dessous.

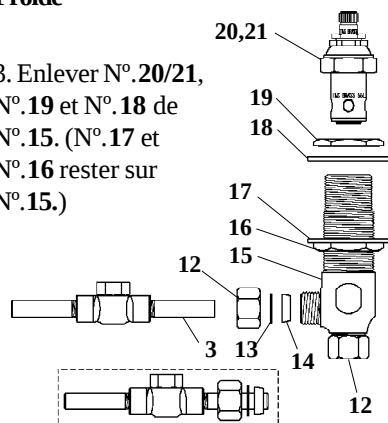


2. Enlever N°.9/11 de N°.2 en tenant N°.4 avec une clef anglaise, puis tourner N°.9/11. Enlever N°.7 et N°.8 de N°.9/11. (N°.3 devoir être bien fermer dans N°.2).



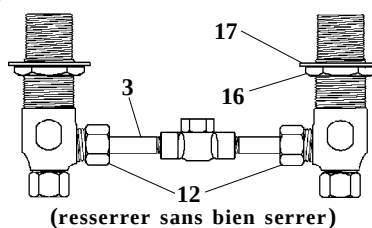
La Soupape Côté Chaude et Froide

3. Enlever N°.20/21, N°.19 et N°.18 de N°.15. (N°.17 et N°.16 rester sur N°.15.)

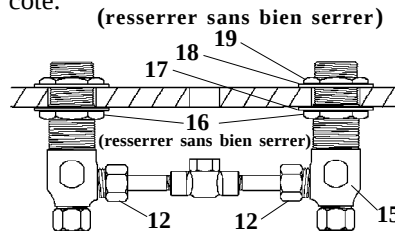


4. Enlever N°.12, N°.13 et N°.14 de N°.15. Assembler les choses précédentes sur le bras de N°.3, comme indiqué (ci-dessous à gauche) chaque côté.

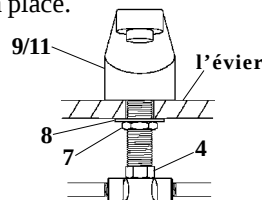
5. Insérer N°.3 sur N°.15, resserrer sans bien serrer N°.12 sur les filets par le main.



6. Mettre l'assemblage N°.15 dans les trous du fond de l'évier. Assembler, approximativement N°.16 et N°.17 au-dessous-de l'évier. Remplacer N°.18 et N°.19 sur N°.15 en haut de l'évier. Resserrer par le main - sans bien serrer. Faire la même chose pour chaque côté.

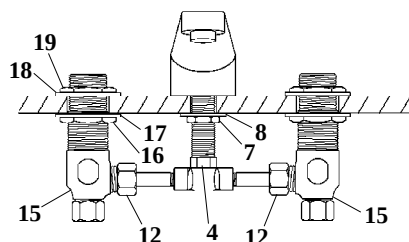


7. Mettre N°.9/11 à travers le trou dans l'évier et remplacer N°.7 et N°.8 sur N°.9/11 du fond de l'évier. Régler N°.16 et N°.19 pour permettre N°.9/11 d'être à sa place.

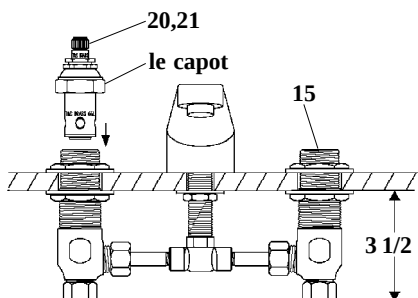
8. Réattacher N°.9/11 à N°.4. Soyez certain que N°.6 être à sa place.
9. Resserer N°.7 avec une clef contre le fond de l'évier.
10. Resserer le N°.16 du bas sur chaque côté de N°.15 sur le fond de l'évier avec une clef anglaise. Aussi resserer N°.12 sur l'assemblage de N°.15.



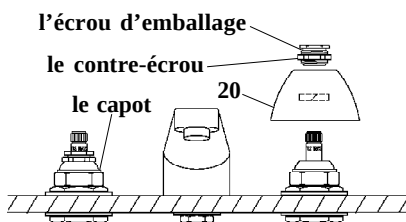
Noter: En resserant N°.7 et N°.16, soyez certain que les N°.15's, tous les deux se situer au même niveau au-dessus-de l'évier. Resserer N°.7 et N°.16 avant vous resserer les N°.19's.

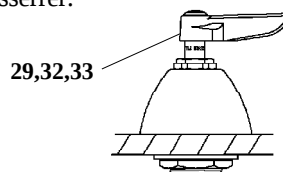
11. Remplacer N°.20 et N°.21 sur chaque côté de N°.15 et resserer les capots pour vous permettre placer la soupape.



12. Enlever l'assemblage de l'écrou d'emballage/ le contre-écrou de N°.20,21 tous les deux.
13. Mettre N°.22 sur chaque N°.20,21.
14. L'écrou d'emballage et le contre-écrou doivent être assemblés approximativement avant remplacer dans N°.20,21. Resserer par le main les contre-écrous seulement contre N°.22. N'utiliser pas une clef.



15. Resserer l'écrou d'emballage contre le contre-écrou en utilisant deux clefs anglaises. Tenir le contre-écrou en tournant l'écrou d'emballage.
16. Attacher N°.29 à N°.20,21 et mettre N°.33 dans le N°.29 approprié. Mettre N°.32 dans N°.33 et N°.29 puis resserer.



17. Brancher les tuyaux qui fournir l'eau, recommencer l'eau et vérifier s'il y a des fuites.

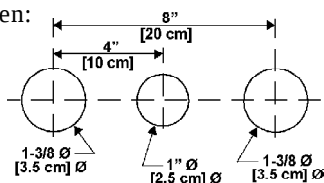
Noter: Peut-être il falloir resserer les capots et les écrous d'emballage pour arrêter la fuite de la sortie ou l'assemblage de la broche.

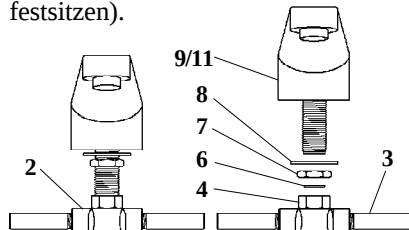

Armaturrumpf und Seitenarmaturen/ Wasserhähne zentrieren.

1. Wasserzufuhr absperren und Wasserleitungen entleeren. 3 (drei) Löcher in den Spültisch oder die Abdeckplatte bohren, in die Nr. 1 installiert wird. Siehe Abbildung unten:

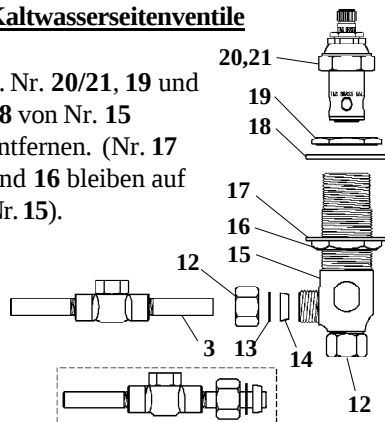


2. Nr. 9/11 von Nr. 2 entfernen, indem Nr. 4 mit einem Schraubenschlüssel festgehalten wird, dann Nr. 9/11 drehen. Nr. 7 und Nr. 8 von Nr. 9/11 entfernen. (Nr. 3 sollte bereits in Nr. 2 festsitzen).



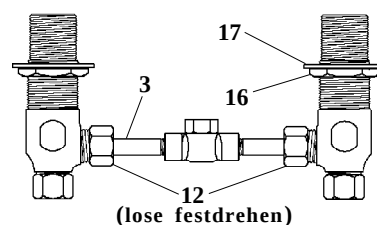
Warm- und Kaltwasserseitenventile

3. Nr. 20/21, 19 und 18 von Nr. 15 entfernen. (Nr. 17 und 16 bleiben auf Nr. 15).

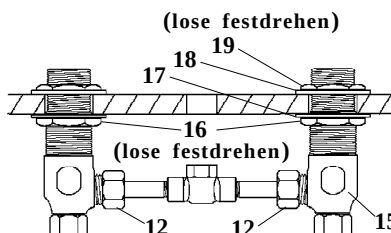


4. Nr. 12, 13 und 14 von Nr. 15 entfernen. Auf beiden Seiten die vorhergehenden Teile auf dem Arm von Nr. 3 aufreihen, wie in der Abbildung (unten links) gezeigt wird.

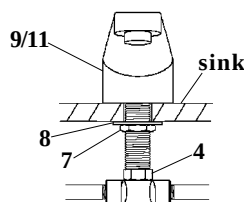
5. Nr. 3 lose in Nr. 15 einfügen, Nr. 12 lose mit der Hand auf dem Gewinde festdrehen.



6. Die Garnitur Nr. 15 von der Unterseite des Spültisches in die Löcher einführen. Nr. 16 und 17 lose unter dem Spültisch zusammensetzen.



7. Nr. 9/11 durch das Loch in dem Spültisch führen und Nr. 7 und 8 wieder von der Unterseite des Spültisches auf Nr. 9/11 aufsetzen. Nr. 16 und 19 justieren, um die ordnungsgemäße Positionierung von Nr. 9/11 zu ermöglichen.

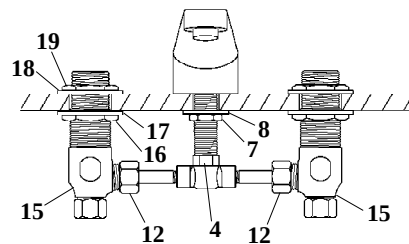

8. Nr. 9/11 wieder mit Nr. 4 verbinden. Sicherstellen, daß sich Nr. 6 am richtigen Platz befindet.

9. Nr. 7 mit einem Schraubenschlüssel gegen die Unterseite des Spültisches festziehen.

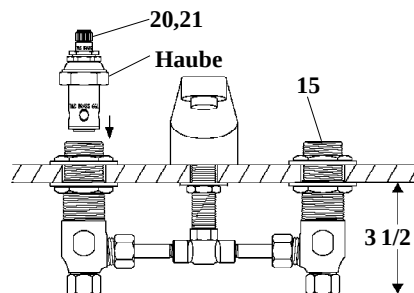
10. Unterseite von Nr. 16 auf beiden Seiten von Nr. 15 auf der Unterseite des Spültisches mit einem Schraubenschlüssel festziehen. Nr.12 auf der Garnitur Nr.15 festziehen.



Anmerkung: Beim Festziehen von Nr. 7 und Nr. 16 sicherstellen, daß beide Nr. 15 sich auf der Oberseite des Spültisches in gleicher Höhe befinden. Nr. 7 und 16 festziehen, bevor Nr. 19 festgezogen wird.

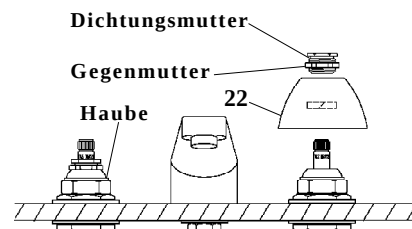
11. Nr. 20 und Nr. 21 auf beide Seiten von Nr. 15 aufsetzen und die Hauben genügend anziehen, um das Ventil einzusetzen.



12. Dichtungsmutter/Gegenmutter-Garnitur von beiden Nr. 20/21 entfernen.

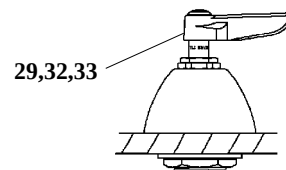
13. Nr. 22 über beide Nr. 20/21 schieben.

14. Dichtungsmutter und Gegenmutter sollten lose zusammengesetzt werden, bevor sie wieder in Nr. 20/21 eingesetzt werden. Dichtungsmuttern mit der Hand nur gegen Nr. 22 anziehen. *Keinen Schraubenschlüssel benutzen.*



15. Dichtungsmutter gegen die Gegenmutter unter Verwendung von zwei Schraubenschlüsseln festziehen. Gegenmutter festhalten, während die Dichtungsmutter gedreht wird.

16. Nr. 29 mit Nr. 20, 21 verbinden und Nr. 33 in die zutreffende Nr. 29 einsetzen. Nr. 32 in Nr. 33 und 29 einsetzen, dann festdrehen.



17. Wasserzufuhr herstellen, Wasserventil öffnen und auf Dichtigkeit prüfen.

Anmerkung: Es kann notwendig sein, daß die Hauben und Dichtungsmuttern festgezogen werden müssen, um Leckstellen vom Auslauf oder um die Spindelgarnitur zu unterbinden

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
