

Vinyl Cushions, Wooden or Melamine Cabinets:

Cleaning, Care & Sanitizing

Cleaning -

- Surfaces may be cleaned with a solution of warm water and a small amount of mild dish detergent. Wipe clean with a cloth dampened in the water/detergent solution and dry immediately with a soft cloth or paper towels to avoid streaking.
- Avoid using abrasive cleaners or cleaners containing ammonia or silicone.
- Never use scrub sponges or steel wool on laminate, melamine or vinyl surfaces.
- Avoid excessive water that may seep into seams. Ensure surfaces are wiped dry after washing.

General Care -

- Do not drop heavy objects on surfaces. It is possible to chip, gouge or rip if a heavy object is dropped on the surface abruptly.
- Do not place hot objects on surfaces. It is possible to blister or warp the surface material.
- Inspect all hardware periodically on furniture, tighten any loose fasteners to maintain the structural strength of the product.

Sanitizing -

- A mixture of household bleach and water (1/4 teaspoon bleach / 1 quart lukewarm water) is the standard sanitizing solution.
- For all surfaces, it is recommended to apply the sanitizing solution using a spray bottle.
 Apply a light mist to dampen the entire surface, avoiding saturation of the surface, seam or edge surface.
- Let the sanitizing solution stand for two minutes.
- Dry the surface to remove the remaining moisture.
- Make sure all cleaning products, including bleach, are clearly labeled and out of the reach
 of children.
