Effects of Overexposure

Emergency and First Aid Procedures

Swallowing: If swallowed, drink milk or water and contact a doctor

immediately.

SECTION VII PRECAUTIONS FOR SAFE HANDLING AND USE

Precautions to be taken in handling and storage

Store in tightly sealed containers in a cool dry place that is well ventilated

Steps to be taken in case material is released or spilled

Small Spill: Cover with a non-combustible materials and remove to an approved disposal container. Wash area with soap and water.

Large Spill: Avoid sources of ignition. Contain spiller material. Cover with a non-combustible material and remove to an approved disposal container. Avoid inhalation of vapors. If in a confined area, NIOSH-approved respiratory protection may be required. Wash area with soap and water. Dry products should be swept up and removed to an approved disposal container. Wash area with soap and water.

Waste Disposal Method

Incinerate, bury in approved manner or dispose of using any procedure which is in conformance with pertinent federal, state, or local regulations.

SECTION VIII PROTECTIVE EQUIPMENT TO BE USED

Respiratory Protection: In well ventilated areas, no respiratory protection is normally

required. In poorly ventilated areas, use NIOSH respirator

Ventilation: Provide adequate ventilation suing a mechanical exhaust fan

Protective gloves: Chemical-resistant gloves recommended. Eye protection: Chemical safety goggles recommended.

Other protective equipment: Eye wash station and safety shower should be easily

accessible.
