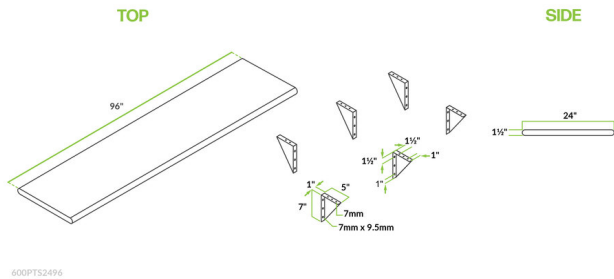

Designed for a wall that is 12 1/2" thick or less, this shelf includes 6 cantilever brackets to simplify installation and allow you to install the shelf where you want it.
